The Story:

The movie “The Majestic” was filmed in Ferndale, California, which became “Lawson” for the filming. Notable Ferndale artist Jack Mays, who has long been documenting Ferndale’s unique history and who spent two years on drawings of “Outbreak”, starring Dustin Hoffman, which was filmed here in 1996, spent several weeks in the spring of 2001 on site, sketching the Majestic Theater, which had been constructed in the town’s parking lot. He chose to draw the facade because of the irony it posed.

“That theater really became symbolic of all small town woes,” he explains. “The first thing they lose is their theater. I saw a parallel with our theater, which is constantly struggling.”

When the drawing was complete he wanted it to be sold and the proceeds used to benefit the local theater. He approached screen-writer Michael Sloane for help in getting the cast and crew to sign the piece. Eventually, Jack Mays was awarded a much coveted “pass” to get onto the sets and the signing began. As it developed, with each signer choosing his “spot” to sign, the pattern of the signatures actually became a major part of the “Art”.

However, when he got to the point where he needed Jim Carrey’s signature, the security team stopped him and caused his pass to be revoked. This action prompted him to draw a cartoon which was published the following week in the local newspaper, the Ferndale Enterprise, (“The Lawson Beacon” in the movie). The cartoon depicted artist Jack Mays being carried off the set by security, upside down with his sketch pad still in his hands. Jim Carrey had not yet signed the drawing.

Those associated with the filming in Ferndale couldn't recall anything like this ever being signed by the cast, crew and local notables, since a movie studio would normally wish to control this type of thing. But because they knew this artwork was going to be donated to the local theater, they signed it...All except Jim Carrey.

The "Majestic" was donated to the local theater, after which a benefit dinner and auction was held. The highlight of the evening was the sale of the original "Majestic" to Lowell Daniels and Jenny Oaks, owners of the Victorian Inn in Ferndale, where many of the cast & crew stayed and/or played during the filming of the movie. All the proceeds went to the Ferndale Repertory Theatre.

The artwork was displayed in the lobby of the Victorian Inn. A few nights later Jim Carrey and a friend came in and sat at the fireplace to relax. Mr. Daniels made them an espresso and then Jim Carrey got up, walked over and signed the artwork, smack dab in the middle. The drawing was now complete!

The movie was set in 1951, so we are printing a limited edition of 1951 copies, each signed and numbered by the artist.

So...what do we have here? A great work of art with a great story attached. A collector's item which can't be matched. And a tribute to the ability of the Movie Industry and a small town to work together and earn respect from each other.

Attached is an alphabetical listing of those who signed the drawing. If you signed this, you must have a copy! If you are a Jim Carrey fan, or a fan of any of the other stars who have signed this, you must have a copy! If you are a collector of movie memorabilia, you must have a copy! And if you simply enjoy fine art, you must have a copy!
